Match Play

Format:

- Matches will be played off the lowest handicap player in each group. The lowest handicap player in each group will play at scratch, with the other players in the group receiving the difference between their handicap and the lowest handicap player. The strokes will fall on the most difficult holes of the 9-hole match as they are represented on the card. All matches will be played at 100% of the player's handicap, and no ½ strokes will be given.
- Four Ball Match-Play.

Nine (9) points will be available for each match as follows:

- Win a hole = 1; Tie a hole = $\frac{1}{2}$.
- Max points awarded to the winners per match will be 9; the losers will be awarded all their points.

Flight Ties:

- Ties will be decided by the result of the head to head match between the two teams previous match.
- If still tied, there will be a One-Hole Playoff starting on Hole #9. The format will be Better Ball of Partners. Handicaps will be at 90%
- A chip off (Both players per team will chip, combined distance, from a location pre-marked by the committee) will be the final method used to break the tie.

Playoff:

The 6 Flight Winners will be grouped into 2 groups of three. All teams will play 5-Holes (T.B.A.) in a 1 Best Ball of 2 Format. Handicaps will be played at 90% with a Maximum Differential 10 between partners. The team with the Lowest Aggregate Team Score will be Crowned Champions. 2nd and 3rd place (for Para-Mutual) will be determined by the next 2 lowest Aggregate Team Scores. If there is a tie for the Overall Champion, a sudden death playoff will occur on hole #9. Ties for 2nd and 3rd will be decided in a chip-off on #9 green.

<u>Chip off:</u> During the chip off (if necessary), <u>opponents are not permitted to watch the chip, and they are not permitted to see the results of their opponent's chip. The Professional Staff will measure the result of each player's chip and remove the balls before the next team turns toward the green to prepare for their chip shots. Both players will chip and their combined distance from the hole will determine 2nd and 3rd place.</u>
