JUNIOR GOLF POLICIES



Junior golf guidelines are made primarily with regard to the safety of our youth

No children seven (7) years of age or younger will be allowed to play on the golf course unless they are accompanied by an adult. Children 8-11 years of age may play golf if accompanied by a sponsor 12 years of age or older.

Children not golfing must be closely supervised at all times.

Fivesomes are not allowed on the course at any time unless approved by the Golf Professional.

Golfers may not tee off without signing in at the golf shop.

During the period from April through October, no player under the age of eighteen years old shall tee off before 2:00 PM on Saturday, Sunday, or a Holiday. If they maintain a course handicap of 10 or better, than may play during this blocked out period.

Course restrictions are in effect during league play. On Tuesdays the course is closed for Women from 4:00 PM until 7:30 PM. On Thursdays the 1st or 10th Tee course is closed for Men from 11:00 AM until Close, from April 1st through October 31st. Practice Area also is restricted after 11:00 AM / Wednesday from 9:00 Am until 11:30 Am Closed for Senior League.

No person under the age of eighteen years old shall participate in any tournaments listed in the Members Tournament Schedule with the exception of the following: Parent Child, Club Championship: Championship Flight if qualified, and Junior Golf Championship.

The Club Professional shall have the authority to enforce the golf course rules at all times.

*****Gambling On the Golf Course Is Strictly Prohibited*****

No one is allowed to drive or rent a motorized cart, unless they have a valid driver's license.

Any person(s) who do not follow the above policies will be subject to loss of golfing privileges.
